Remember when Stormont couldn't meet because Sinn Fein said no? Stormont at the grace and favour of Sinn Fein is not worth having.

We want proper democracy, durable government and an Opposition. You deserve the right to vote a party out of office - yet you can't, because of the folly of mandatory coalition.

Root and branch change is vital. We need you to join us in building a better Northern Ireland. Let's, together, keep TUV's momentum going.
